6. Director's Report – NATA Updates: Cari Wood

- CAATE Open comment period. Please go on their website and add your comments. Closes July 30th.
- NATA Funding a 2-year position for an ACO to hire an Athletic Trainer to contract with providers to provide patient care.
- Custom fitted orthotics rule proposal has been shelved with US government changes that have occurred. Overtime rule is also likely to dissolve.
- BOC has BOD opening, closing is July 5th.
- Sign up for your NPI. Students can get NPI's. (Could be a HIPAA violation if you don't have one).
- State legislative grants open July 1st. NATA is giving out \$600,000 for state associations.

7. State Presidents Reports

- Idaho – Nikki Clark - State meeting is July 21st and 22nd in Lewiston. One of the sessions is a 2-hour open lab for brain dissection. Lt gov. issued an executive order to have all medical licensure reviewed. Keeping a close eye on the outcome.
- Oregon – Sam Johnson - Summer symposium July 8th, in Portland
- Montana – Val Moody - HB 487 which revised Montana's Dylan Steigers Protection of Youth Athletes Act to include youth sports organizations was passed this session and the governor will be in Missoula July 10th to sign the bill. The MTATA Annual State Meeting was held in Helena June 3 with approximately 45 in attendance. A \$15 dues increase proposal was presented to the membership and approved.
- Washington – Craig Bennett/Jen Carroll - WA held a Concussion Symposium on May 6th at the VMAC that was well attended and successful. State meeting is coming on July 15th at the University of Washington. There will be 4 Category A and 2 EBP credits available.
- Alaska – Chris Dean/Lynne Young - Finished 3rd legislative special session, just finished elections. Contemplating opening practice act.
